Half zips made of PES/CLY and PES/CLY in blend with PES (recycled)/CO/EL and PES/CLY/EL, recycled content <20% from post-consumer PET bottles. Trousers made of PA in blend with PES/EL, PES/CO/EL in blends with PES/CO and PES, PES/CO/EL in blends with PES and PA with PU coating all with water repellent finishing. Sweaters and vest made of PES/CO/EL in blend with PES/EL and PES with water repellent finishing. Jackets made of PA with water repellent finishing. Including accessories: Zippers, sewing thread, interlining, padding, velcro, elastics, reflective tape, buttons, woven and printed labels, ribbons and cords, heat transfer prints, ceramic print, embroidery patch and plastic and metal trims. Produced using components partly pre-certified according to OEKO-TEX® STANDARD 100.
